

Finding coded medical concepts Some problems

- Keyboard text search problems when very large dictionary of concepts
- Can result in long lists
 and complex hierarchies
- Need to filter extensively


Idiopathic aldosteronism


Visual Navigation using Anatomy

- Clinicians are all trained in anatomy so understand the navigation method
- Anatomy is constant (over non-evolutionary time scales!) so navigation method stays constant
- Image/word association is usually easy
- Rapid filtering of concepts because very granular classification


